The Capri Car Club hosts a race day as part of The Surgery Intermarque Sprint Series at the Manfield Race Track each year. This is a great event; good fun for members racing and for members who support the club at this event by assisting with flag marshalling and time-keeping.

Club members compete for Club Racing Trophies by accumulating points gained by entering any other race events throughout the year and forwarding their results to the club's race co-ordinator. Trophies are awarded at each AGM.

1. To be eligible for points a driver must be a paid up member of the Capri Car Club of NZ.
2. Points will be allocated to drivers for competing in a Motor Race meeting held under a MANZ permit.
3. To receive points a official result sheet must to received by either Lindsay Lyons or Brian Hamilton within 7days of the event being held.
4. Points will be awarded for the position of car in result sheet.
5. Points will be awarded as follows,

For entering meeting but unable to start qualifying.	5
For qualifying	10
1st place	30
2nd place	20
Followed by 3rd down to 15th	15 – 1
Lower than 15th	1

6. Double points will be allocated at any meeting organized by Capri Car Club NZ
7. Any vehicle can be used for overall points
8. Points will be allocated for classes within overall points.

 - Ford Capri <3101 cc
9. Points can be allocated for any Race meeting held anytime between the AGM of the Capri Car Club NZ of one year up to the next AGM the following year.
